

IRF UNIFORM POLICY Approved September 29, 2023 Effective January 1, 2024

- C.1. All athletes must wear country identification while competing (name and/or emblem) on the backs of their shirts clearly visible from the outside to the referee, spectators, and the media.
- C.1.a. For men's doubles teams, both partners must wear the same complete uniform (identical shirt and shorts relative to style, material, colors, graphics, and/or emblems), with the only exception being if the name of the player is included on the shirt. If one player has their name on the shirt, the other must have this feature as well.
- C.1.b. For women's doubles, section C.1.a applies except that one partner may wear shorts and the other a skirt/skort, but these must match exactly relative to material, colors, graphics, and/or emblems.
- C.1.c. For mixed doubles teams, the participants must wear the same version of their national team uniform (matching material, colors, graphics, and/or emblems) but males and females can wear styles made for their gender if they so desire. If one player has their name on the shirt, the other must have this feature as well.
- C.1.d. Regarding shorts/skirts/skorts, the length may vary, but these must match exactly relative to style, material, colors, graphics, and/or emblems.
- C.1.e. Athletes must have additional shirts ready to use if they perspire (sweat) so much as to create a safety hazard on the court. Relative to style, material, colors, graphics, and/or emblems, the shirt must match the shirt of the athlete's partner if in a doubles match (see C.1, C.1.a, C.1.b, C.1.c), or both athletes must change shirts so that they continue to match.
- C.1.f. During the warm-up period, players may wear a jacket or long pants at their discretion, but it must always be part of the National Team Uniform. For Doubles divisions, one player may wear a jacket or long pants and the other player may not.

Tournament management reserves the right to deliberate and rule on any uniform situation that may arise at an event.
